SEDA Malaysia has been working very hard since the first quarter of this year to ensure the e-FiT Online System becomes more robust and user friendly. We have now almost completed the enhancement exercise and this Roadshow is conducted as a part of our effort to prepare the RE players to be familiar on the enhancements made to the feed in tariff applications.

4. Today's Roadshow will include two sessions of public briefing which will be presented by Ir Ali Askar the chief operating officer and the ICT director Mr Leong. The first briefing will be on the amendments to the subsidiary legislation affecting the FiT applications while the second will be on the enhanced features and facilities of the e-FiT online system. These will be followed by a Q&A session and lastly in the afternoon there will be a demonstration of the enhanced e-FiT online system. I anticipate this workshop will provide the participants of today's road show the essential knowledge required both technical and regulatory to the feed in tariff mechanism.
